



LOWER BUCKS DOG TRAINING CLUB, INC.

CONSTITUTION

- Section 1. The name of the club shall be LOWER BUCKS DOG TRAINING CLUB, INC.
- Section 2. The objectives of this club shall be:
- (a) To advance the canine world by making both dog and owner more useful members of society.
 - (b) To promote better understanding, respect and companionship between dogs and their handler-trainers,
 - (c) To educate the general public in all phases of canine development and dog training, making this information easily accessible to all.
 - (d) To promote reputable, responsible, humane training practices and procedures,
 - (e) To create a nonprofit organization and to establish facilities in the Lower Bucks area of Pennsylvania in order to provide classes in all phases of dog training.
 - (f) To conduct matches and licensed trials under the rules and regulations of the American Kennel Club.
 - (g) To do all in its power to protect and advance the interests of obedience training by encouraging sportsmanlike competition at dog shows and to maintain the best relations among members of this Club and their canine companions.
- Section 3. The Club shall not be conducted or operated for profit and no part of any profits or remainder or residue from dues or donations to the Club shall inure to the benefit of any member or individual. Trainers can be paid by the Club as determined by the Board of Directors. Nonmember trainers may be hired on a contractual basis. Any profits accrued by the Club shall be devoted to the above objectives or donated to such charitable or civic organizations as shall be approved by a majority vote of the members voting at a regular Club meeting prior to the close of the year's books.
- Section 4. The voting members of the Club shall adopt and may, from time to time, revise such bylaws as may be required to carry out these objectives.
