




Lois DiMarzio:





Pet Food Drive

Dear Club members:

I speak with the directors of both food pantries every two weeks. As of today, 9/29, they are good with their current inventory of pet food. I will arrange for 2020 Holiday pet food donations the second week of November funded from your generous support of our May 2020 Food Drive Campaign. The Salvation Army's delivery will again come directly from

Chewy.com. However, the Emergency Relief Association cannot accept UPS deliveries directly. I'll shop for their donations and will deliver directly to them via SUV or my friend's panel van. The ERA practices social distancing and their volunteers will unload our vehicles and stock their shelves. As with our spring delivery, we are not allowed into the building due to Covid restrictions.

These two holiday donations will almost deplete our account which is managed closely by our treasurer, Kris King. We will not be able to conducts our usual pet food drive in early November at ShopRite in Fairless Hills due to Covid 19 restrictions. So to begin funding our club's pet food drive account for the coming winter, Kris and I will begin another food drive campaign in November requesting donations from our generous Club members.

I solicited a \$25 gift card from Giant Grocery in Yardley on September 10th and purchased pet food from the store which was on sale. That was delivered to the ERA. I have also solicited a \$100 Community Gift card from ShopRite in Fairless Hills. Once I receive it, I'll purchase pet food for holiday delivery.
