Take a leap of faith and rejoin.


Any member, who has not renewed by <u>January 15, 2021</u>, will be removed from our membership list. We will assume that you are not going to join us for 2021.



Pet Food Drive

Dear Club Members,

Thank you.....all of you.....for your unwavering support of our Pet Food Drives this year. Because of your generous hearts and personal contributions, we were able to donate 2,239 pounds of pet food to local food pantries this year. All pet food purchased this year was funded by the generous personal donations of our club members during our Spring Pet Food Campaign in May. Total pounds of pet food donated by LBDTC this year is 2,239. When we add that to previous 9 years of donations of 47,503 pounds, our total YTD donated pet food is 49,742 pounds or **24.871 tons** of pet food since LBDTC started pet food drives.

2020 was a challenging year for all of us in so many ways. We all learnedor tried to learn.....to deal with personal COVID health issues with our family; employment issues; working from home; virtual schooling for our children; creative ways to keep our dogs

out of mischief and trouble. Creatively, we still held our AKC trials, worked to bring minimum income into LBDTC with training classes for our members to help with our expenses. Despite all these frustrations and personal obligations, you still found it in your hearts to help pets in need by generously contributing to LBDTC's support of Bucks County's local food pantries. On behalf of the food pantries, thank you for helping their members keep their pets comfortable and well fed this vear.

Here's our activity for December 2020:

We received information from Donna Worthington in mid-December that the Family Service Association of Bucks County opened a pet food pantry at 4 Cornerstone Drive off Woodbourne Road in Langhorne. After contacting Kathleen Megahan at FSABC, we donated 135 pounds of pet food to their new location on Christmas Eve, December 24th

219 pounds of pet food was delivered to the Emergency Relief Association also on Woodbourne Road on December 23rd.

An additional 60 pounds of pet food was delivered to the ERA on December 28 to supplement their December 23rd delivery

125 pounds of pet food was delivered to the Salvation Army of Levittown directly from Chewy from LBDTC on December 10th.
