Making of a Therapy Dog

Tri-State K9 Crisis Response Team is highlighting the making of a therapy dog on their Facebook page. They are profiling two different dogs, One is Logan a golden puppy bred to be a therapy dog and the other is our own Lois DiMarzio's Gypsy, a girl from the streets who's not talking about her past life.

Lois DiMarzio is sharing the first chapter of Gypsy's story.

THE MAKING OF A THERAPY DOG - GYPSY'S START

Introducing PHBT Gypsies, Tramps and Thieves

Gypsy is a 2-year old female with a mysterious past. Pregnant and alone, she appeared in the North Carolina backyard of a woman who had 2 little girls. She was so sweet that the family kept her, named her "Baby", and the girls played dress-up with her. More than a month after the 7 puppies were

born, the woman contracted Covid and had to turn Baby and her puppies over to a shelter. The shelter contacted the Philly Bully Team (PHBT) who transported them to Philadelphia. The puppies all found foster families right away but Baby still needed a loving family. Fortunately, Lois' daughter Caitlin persuaded her to foster Baby because Lois had fostered many female golden retrievers who had been rescued from their bondage in puppy mills.

Before Baby/Gypsy became part of Lois' family, Lois and her Golden Retriever Kerri, were members of Tri-State's Crisis Response Team and twice a week would Zoom with the mental health patients at Virtua-Willingboro. A patient there recommended the name "Gypsy" and PHBT agreed to it. So even before she arrived in Philadelphia, Gypsy impacted the lives of people experiencing emotional difficulties. Within 36 hours of her arrival in Lois's house, she appeared in her first Zoom visit and virtually met the person who named her.

Gypsy is a cuddler and a snuggler who quickly stole Lois' and John's hearts. They adopted Gypsy on Halloween, 2020. Since Lois has had 2 Crisis Response dogs, she was aware of the skills and traits required of an excellent therapy dog. Covid has slowed down opportunities to get Gypsy lots of exposure to different experiences but Lois takes advantage of any and every opportunity she sees, such as loud noisy equipment digging up her road, walking on various surfaces, and ignoring little dogs that walk past her barking and straining on their leashes. Since Lois doesn't know what

Gypsy knows or how it was learned, she assumes everything is new to Gypsy and approaches it confidently but with a watchful eye on Gypsy's reaction. So far, nothing has fazed Gypsy. Gypsy is enrolled in a "refresher" course at Lower Bucks Dog Training Club because that's all that is offered at this time because of Covid. The class is very small and geared to improving and expanding skills. Gypsy is the star of the class. Maybe she had classes before she became a street walker.

Watch for more Kerri and Gypsy adventures as Kerri shows Gypsy how to become a perfect therapy dog.
