

#### **Pet Food Drive**

LBDTC 2021 HOLIDAY PET FOOD PROGRAM

\$580 donated as of 11/28/21 by 14 LBDTC members.

A second email was sent out on October 22 to members reminding them to donate to the pet food campaign which has been extended through December 15, 2021

Calls were made to directors of all 3 food pantries; they were in need of additional pet food. Deliveries made to Salvation Army of Levittown; Emergency Relief Association (ERA) in Langhorne and Family Services Association of Bucks County on Woodbourne Road. \$279 spent at PetSmart for pet food for pantries.

\$100 gift card from ShopRite of Fairless Hills; pet food purchased and delivered to SA \$25 gift card from Giant of Yardley; pet food purchased and delivered to ERA

Through our previous purchases of pet food for the pantries, the assistant manager of PetSmart on Oxford Vallev Road has offered me stuffed pet toys to donate to the food pantries. A photo is attached of a sample of the toys and the first 15 bags stacked in my garage. The toys are a substantial size, about 14 inches high, and 8 inches wide, all wearing a red scarf with snowflake and 2021 on the scarf. They are tagged "I've been donated."

The assistant manager at PetSmart asked me for verification that we are non profit and that all toys would be donated and I confirmed their request in a letter. The toys are in large, clear bags in either 20 or 25 toys per bag. I have about 25 bags in my garage, just waiting to be donated. This past week I've distributed 3 bags of 25 to the ERA on Woodbourne Road: 5 bags of 20 to Toys for Tots and 13 bags of 25 toys per bag to the Salvation Army.

In the next week, 3 bags will go to the Family Services Association of Bucks County on Woodbourne Road. The Salvation Army Family store off New Falls Road will begin turning their gymnasium into Santa's workshop this week. Their Angel Tree committee will begin putting together donations of toys for close to 500 families with 900 children from our neighboring towns who have registered for Christmas/Holiday donations to be delivered. I've arranged to use my friend's van to pick up

the stuffed toys from PetSmart and to deliver directly to the Salvation Army for this program. I'm hoping to be delivering 20 bags more of 25 stuffed toys per bag for the SA in the upcoming week.

Each organization will receive written notification of the donations acknowledging PetSmart as the donor and LBDTC as the transporter of the stuffed toys for the food pantries.






ISC events are based on international agility rules. All courses were designed and judged by Anastasia Egorova, a Russian Cinological Federation & FCI judge from Moscow.
