Our generous community donated **802 pounds of pet food** at our 2024 Summer Pet Food Drive on Saturday which was held at ShopRite Fairless Hills in the Queen Anne Plaza. To date through these pet food drives, LBDTC has coordinated

the donation of **55,958 pounds** (or **27.97 tons**) of pet food to three local Bucks County food pantries: The Salvation Army of Levittown, The Emergency Relief Association and Family Services Association of Bucks County.

Please feel free to call, text or email me if you have any questions. I look forward to seeing many of you soon.


