He eventually switched to Shellies because he said Keesies were not structurally sound for repeated jumping. He had great success in the ring with Bairnie. I believe they earned a UD. He wanted

to be a judge, but I don't think he ever became one. They moved to a retirement village in upstate PA and dropped out of LBDTC.

He was a great friend and mentor to many members of the club through the years. Those who have belonged to the club for a lot of years might remember John wearing kilts to the awards banquets.




